Stay vigilant this festive season to keep yourself safe from crimes



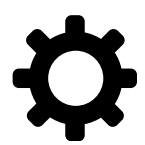
CREATE STRONG PASSWORDS

Use passwords that are hard to guess, and keep track of it using a password manager.



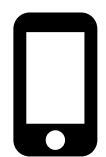
BE CAREFUL OF WHERE YOU PUT YOUR INFO

Don't download content from sites that are not trustworthy as they may contain malware, always look for URLs that start with "https" and have a padlock icon in the address bar.



AVOID CLICKING ON UNKNOWN LINKS

Instead of clicking links in promotional emails, go directly to the retailer's website by typing the URL into your browser. This helps avoid phishing scams.



MONITOR YOUR ACCOUNTS

Regularly check your bank and credit card statements for any unauthorised transactions. Report any suspicious activity immediately.



KEEP YOUR SOFTWARE UPDATED

Keep your anti-virus software updated so it can detect potential threats in your system.
