Vehicle Crime

Theft of and from motor vehicles is a priority that is always on the rise in the autumn and winter months. And will conduct an uplift in high visible patrols in the area.

Shoplifting

This continues to be a policing priority and officers will continue to use Police systems to identify trends, patterns and hot spot areas, and will target these locations with high visibility patrols. As well as plain clothes operations in these locations.

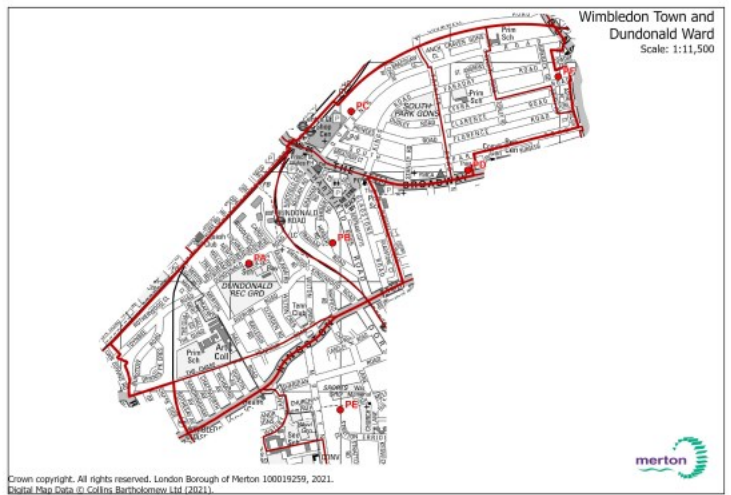
Theft From Person

We will take a similar view as Shoplifting and make sure we do patrols in the areas that have a high theft of person crime.

Violence Against Women & Girls

Target patrols at the times and places that people feel vulnerable with nights drawing in. To include alleyways and poorly lit roads. Licensed premises areas and main transport links for commuters.

Officers to carry out uniform and non uniform patrols.

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Vehicle Crime



Vehicle crime continues to be an issue within the local and surrounding wards, we have increased patrols, spoken with residents and offered crime prevention advice. We would advise all residents to not leave valuables on display and not to store tools inside the vehicle.

Vehicle Security Measures

- Wheel Clamps, Suitable for all vehicle types and immobilize the vehicle.
- Faraday Bags for Keyless vehicles, This protects the keys from unauthorised and hacking attempts.
- Steering wheel locks are a visible deterrent and prevent the vehicle from being driven away.
- Driveway bollards offer the greatest protection by offering a physical barrier preventing theft.

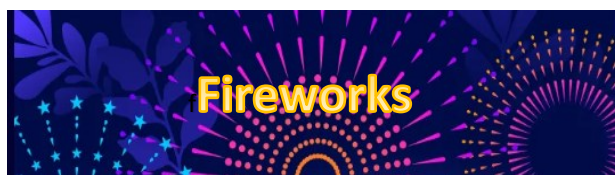

Here is our advice for elderly or vulnerable residents:

- If you are expecting a delivery or visit from a professional always ask for ID or confirmation of their work place.
- If you have a door chain make sure it is securely fastened at all times and lock your porch door
