Report 1

Residential Burglary – FOUR (4) BURGLARIES and THREE (3) Attempted

Hotspot areas:

- 1. Three (3) Attempted burglaries – i) suspect seen on CCTV wearing a face mask and standing in the back garden, ii) Victim was asleep when someone tried to open the flat door and the safety bar fell onto the ground waking the victim. iii) Suspect entered the block of flats from a communal door and tried to break into the flat. The victim kept him out.

- 2. Four (4) burglaries a) suspect entered rear garden and entry/exit point was from the rear window. Jewellery stolen. CCTV present. b) Parcel stolen from a communal post room CCTV present. c) Suspects broke into a Café and broke the key box to gain entry. CCTV present. d) Victim came home and disturbed the suspects during their burglary. No CCTV present.

Hotspot areas: *North and South of the Ward*

What times? *Monday, Tuesday x 2, Thursday, Friday & Saturday*

- 1. Car damaged when parked on street. [Keeping vehicles safe | Crime prevention | Metropolitan Police](#)
- 2. Entered and tampered with steering wheel lock. 3. Car interference. 4. Victim's Van broken into and work tools stolen
- Two (2) Parcel shelves stolen. Always remember to take your parcel shelf inside.
- ✓ **Remember: Empty car policy – Nothing to see, nothing to take!**
- ✓ **Remember** to look after your disabled Blue Badges - if not secured in a disabled Badge holder (see image).

- **Do Faraday bags work for key fobs?**
- **A Faraday bag will protect your keyless entry fob from being hacked and used to start your car without you knowing.** Faraday sleeves protect valuable devices from electronic pickpockets and vehicles from electronic car thieves

- **Remember: Advise to the Wise – “A Tracker installed in the motor vehicle help to locate and recover the vehicle”.**
- How do police track stolen cars?
- When a vehicle is stolen the Tracker device emits a unique Very High Frequency signal. This can be picked by the police **using the Tracker technology installed in their vehicles** to help track stolen vehicles. A tracker was installed in the motor vehicle, and the owners of the car were able to locate & recover. (*Tracker™ Vehicle Tracking Systems* *Utilise VHF Tracking to Help Locate Your Stolen Vehicle*)

- **Time:** Day & Evening **Date:** Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday x 2 Hotspot areas: East of the ward.
- CRIME PREVENTION ADVICE – **Remember personal safety**
- ONE (1) – care home pickpocket
- ONE (1) - purse stolen from person shopping in a supermarket
- ONE 1 – Daughter stole passport from mother
- ONE (1) A fraudulent call stating they are from FCA and asked for debit/credit cards to be handed over to Courier. Monies stolen.
- ONE (1) – Iphone snatched by Ebike Rider [crime-prevention-handbook.pdf](#)
