

## Safer Neighbourhood News

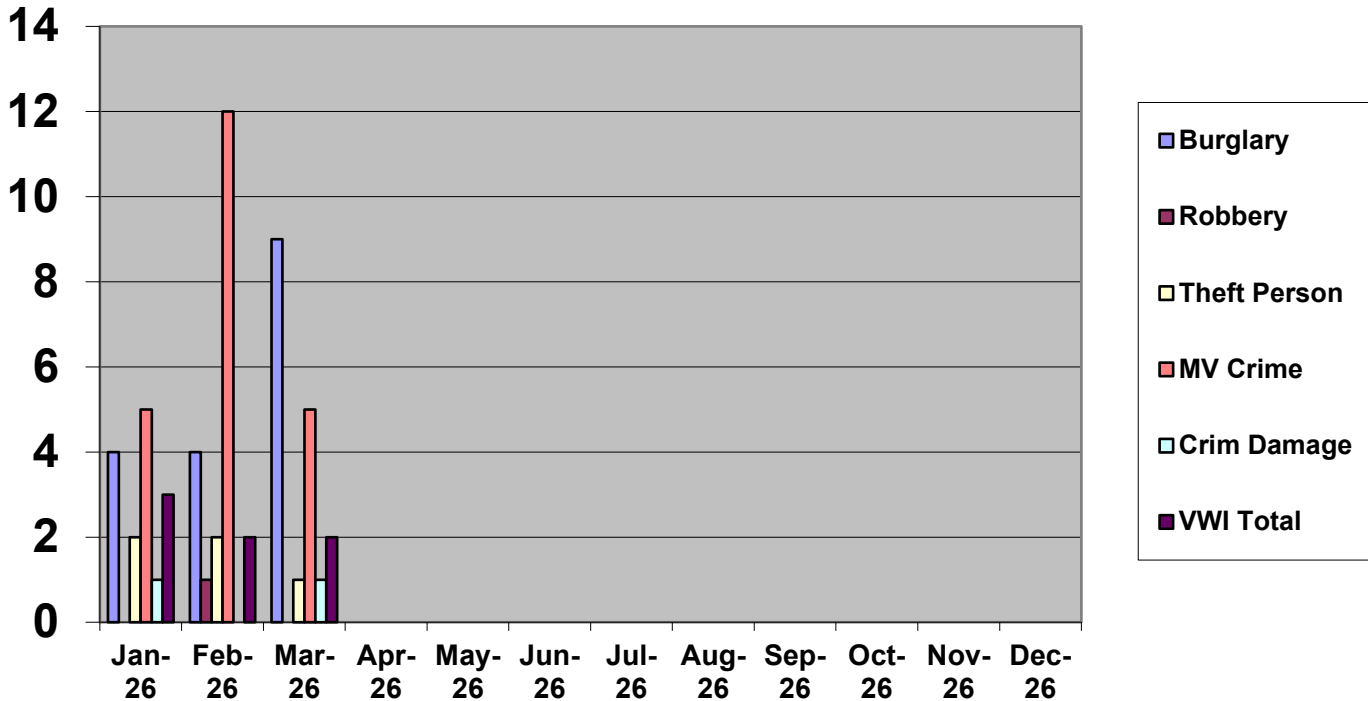
