Penultimately, we would like to trumpet the launch of our new system Met.Engage it is particularly relevant to those of you who live and work in separate locations – this could be a teacher, social worker, council employee whose place of employment is in Peckham but who resides elsewhere, or a local councillor who represents one part of the borough but lives in another.

The advice we have been given is it's not possible to register for two different areas under the same email. To register for Met. Engage from your home address you will need to use your home address and personal email – to register from your place of work you will need to register using your work address and work email.

Whilst this means having two Met.Engage accounts (which you will have to access separately) you will be able to keep up to date with events both where you live and the area you work.
