Visits to local businesses to improve **crime prevention measures**

Crime prevention advice | Metropolitan Police

The Metropolitan Police offer a range of crime prevention advice to help keep vehicles and their contents safe from theft. Here are some key points to consider:

- **Lock your vehicle:** Always lock your vehicle, even when you’re just going to be away for a moment. Ensure that all windows and the sunroof are closed to prevent ‘fishing’ by thieves. [1](#)
- **Secure your number plates:** Use tamper-resistant screws to secure your vehicle’s number plates, making it harder for thieves to change the identity of a stolen vehicle. [1](#)
- **Fit locking, anti-tamper wheel nuts:** Secure your alloy wheels with locking wheel nuts to reduce the risk of theft. [1](#)
- **Hide valuables:** Keep mobile phones, coins, sunglasses, and other valuables with you or hide them in a safe place. [1](#)
- **Keep keys safe:** Keep your keys out of sight and away from your front door to prevent cloning. [1](#)
