East Sheen

East Sheen officers have been busy investigating a particular location where their address has attracted unwanted attention and has caused concerns for a number of local residents. This has varied from drug related activities, anti social behaviour and persons being seen attending the address throughout the day and night.

With such a large built up of evidence and a bundle for the case file, officers were able to obtain a full closure at the address where now the MALE has been removed and the address is currently secured stopping any access.





Further to the closure carried out, officers have seen the MALE where he was stopped and searched and found in possession of a number of stolen goods for which he was dealt with.

The MALE was given a date to attend court however did not present himself on the date and this resulted in him being circulated as wanted and was seen on the same day at the location of his old address where East Sheen officers arrested him for failing to appear.

East Sheen officers are hoping that this sends out a message to all other persons that have been linked to this address highlighting that such behaviour will not be tolerated.

North Richmond

North Richmond officers have been involved in a number of incidents relating to activities involving drugs where a stop and search resulted in Class A and B being seized as well as further anti social behaviour warnings were issued to an address which had been highlighted by local residents for the use of drugs and nuisance behaviour.

Officer have also worked alongside the Kew team where they were able to identify a MALE known for a number of burglaries and Pedal cycle theft who was then arrested and charged for such outstanding reports as he was currently circulated as wanted.





Through routine patrols carried out by Kew officers, they were able to recognise a MALE who has previously been involved in suspicious activities in relation to drugs, officers attempted to stop the MALE however he fled from the scene but a large amount of Class A and B found on the back of a E-Bike which was then seized by the officers. Kew officers hope that removing such a large amount sends out a message to any others and also disrupts any drug movement from taking place in the future.

Kew

The Kew team have carried out 2 x arrests in relation to a MALE linked to incidents regarding shop lifting and have also been investigating an incident in relation to a dangerously out of control dog, after speaking to the owner, a seizure of the dog took place due to the significant injuries that were sustained by the other dog involved.
