Operational Activity – Last 3 Months

Over the past three months, policing activity within Faraday Ward has included an amazing:

- **100 arrests**
- **204 stop and searches**
- **18 Community Protection Warnings / Community Protection Notices (CPW/CPNs) being issued**

Successful Warrant Execution Demonstrates Outstanding Teamwork

A successful warrant was recently executed under the leadership of PC Hepple, resulting in the recovery of significant intelligence. Information obtained during the warrant suggests the possible importation of controlled drugs from California, providing valuable lines of enquiry for ongoing investigations.

This achievement highlights the excellent partnership working and dedication of officers across multiple teams. The operation was a true joint effort involving the Faraday Safer Neighbourhood Team, North Walworth Safer Neighbourhood Team, Town Centre Team, Special Crime Unit, and Response Team.

The success of the warrant is a testament to the professionalism, commitment, and collaborative approach demonstrated by all involved. By combining intelligence, resources, and operational expertise, officers were able to deliver a positive outcome and generate important opportunities to further disrupt criminal activity within our communities.
