### East Sheen

Keeping an eye out whilst off duty played a huge part when one of the East Sheen officers was able to come across a stolen moped near the footpath behind Putney town rowing club. After carrying out further checks, it was confirmed that the moped was stolen from East Sheen and we were able to get the moped to the owner in under 24 hours of the incident taking place.



Through regular patrols, the East Sheen officers have targeted an area that has been highlighted for suspicious activities being carried out during the night.

We have seen a positive result in numerous stop and searches, as well as, community protection notices being issued.

### North Richmond

There have been numerous reports of anti social behaviour at a specific address in North Richmond. Officers have been engaging with partner agencies and the residents of the address.

As a result, a number of anti social behaviour warnings have been issued, as well as, two community protection warnings.

Through targeted patrols within the area, a number of stop and searches have been undertaken to disrupt drug related activity in the area.





## Kew

A prolific shoplifter, wanted for a number of offences was sighted by one of the officers and with the help of a dog unit, he was found hiding under a vehicle and was arrested at the scene.

A number of officers from many wards played a huge part here putting in a containment around the suspect and then being able to locate him.

There has a number of low level anti social behavior reports made to the team. These have been resolved by ASB warnings being issued to the individuals concerned.

The matters were discussed with the persons involved and the concerns were highlighted which will be addressed moving forward.
