Independent Police Advisers - Camden

Do you want the chance to make a valuable contribution to the safety and security of your community?

Do you think you could help improve policing and make Camden a safer place?

- We are looking for volunteers (over the age of 18) to join the Independent Advisory Group (IAG) and provide independent advice to the Metropolitan Police in the London Borough of Camden.
- The IAG works in genuine partnership with the police- acting as "critical friends" in terms of independent advice and input. The IAG provides a sounding board on the potential impact on communities of police practices, training and operations.
- IAG members are drawn from the local community. As an IAG member you will be asked to provide advice from your unique perspective and local knowledge. Independent Advisers may have the opportunity to directly influence local operational activities and enhance the quality of service the Metropolitan Police Service delivers to the benefit of all Londoners.
- No specific training or background is necessary to be an Independent Adviser your life experience, skills and knowledge is enough.
- The IAG is not party-political. You must have a willingness to express your opinion respectfully. It is also not a heavy time commitment.

- Places are limited so we may run a simple selection process via email, telephone, video conferencing or in person.
