Successful dispersal order in Burgess Park

We are pleased to share a positive outcome following the implementation of a dispersal order in Burgess Park over the past weekend.

In response to increasing reports of antisocial behavior and large unauthorized gatherings, a Section 35 dispersal order was authorized to prevent further escalation and ensured the park remained a safe, welcoming space for all.

Thanks to proactive planning and dedicated policing, the operation provided highly effective in maintaining public safety and addressing the concerns raised by residents and community stakeholders.

Over the course of the order, officers engaged with numerous individuals and groups, offering clear explanations of the order and encouraging voluntary compliance. Multiple individuals were directed to leave the area without incident. One arrest was necessary but the overall atmosphere remained calm and cooperative.
