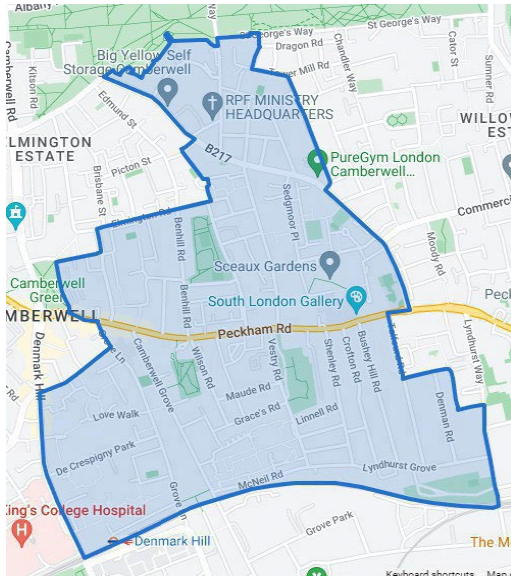
What we have been doing in your community

St Giles Safer Neighbourhood Team officers carried out daily weapon sweeps across the ward searching for discarded knives or weapons. We carried out some of these searches in partnership with Southwark Council Wardens. During one search we recovered a pickaxe found on the grass in the D'Eynsford Estate, SE5.

On the same day we found the pickaxe we also found a moped parked on the Peabody Estate SE5 with a loose chain around the wheel giving the appearance it was locked up. Officers were suspicious about where the moped was parked due to it being hidden away from public eye. Upon checking the mopeds license plate registration number, we discovered it had been reported stolen the previous month to police. We contacted the owner who came down and collected their moped, grateful that it had been recovered by police.

We also assisted Nunhead and Queens Road SNT in Queens Road SE15 as part of a policing operation targeting mopeds, e-bikes and e-scooters to identify persons riding these vehicles who are committing traffic offences and other criminality.

This resulted in seizing 11 e-bikes, 6 mopeds and 2 e-scooters alongside 20 reported traffic offences and an arrest for immigration offences.
